Friendship Star You will make one 12" inch star and two 6" inch stars.
Cutting

| Center of star | 1 square <br> @ 4-1/2" |  | 2 squares <br> @ 2-1/2" |  |

## Sewing

Match up the two 4-7/8" squares of background to a 4-7/8" star point, right sides together. Draw a diagonal line from one corner to the other.
Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from each side of the drawn line.


Cut the squares in half on the drawn line.


Press to the lighter fabric. Finished block should measure 4-1/2".
For 6" stars, repeat this process with the four 2-7/8" squares of background and star point fabric. Finished block should measure 2-1/2".

[^0]Pay close attention to the illustration for placement. Sew rows together as shown. Watch which way your half-square twists. Press seams away from half-square triangles.


Next - sew rows together, matching seams at intersections. Make sure to catch the point of the half-square triangle right at the $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam. Press seams toward the center of your Friendship Star.


Make one block measuring 12-1/2" and two blocks measuring 6-1/2".
