

## Sewing Star Points

On each "star point" square, draw one diagonal line from corner to corner. For each background rectangle, match up the first "star point" square at top and in the corner of the background rectangle, right sides together. Sew right on the drawn line.



Trim 1/4" away from the sewn line. Press the seams toward the triangle.




Add the second "star-point" square on the opposite side in the same manner. Make sure your diagonal line goes from upper outside corner to lower center. It will cross over the first triangle just enough for your point to be at the 1/4" seam-line. Finished units should measure 6-1/2"  $\times$  3-1/2" for your 12" block or 3-1/2"  $\times$  2" for your 6" block.




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**Assembling the star blocks**. Pay close attention to the illustration for placement. Sew rows together as shown. Make sure to catch the intersection of your star points at the 1/4" seam. Press seams away from rectangles.



Next - sew rows together, matching seams at intersections. Make sure to catch the intersection of your star points at the 1/4" seam. Press seams toward the center of your Sawtooth Star. Finished blocks should measure: 1 block@ 12-1/2" and 4 blocks @ 6-1/2".



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
