
Friendly Star You will make one 12" inch star and four 6" inch stars.



12" block (6" Block measurements are in paranthesis):


1. Cut the 5-1/4" (3-1/4") squares in quarters, corner to corner, to create 4 triangles.



2. Match each background triangle to a star triangle, right sides together. Sew a 1/4' seam down one short side. See illustration. Sew the exact same side to all your triangle pairs. Press to the background.




3. Cut the 4-7/8" (2-7/8") squares (star points) in half once, corner to corner.




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4. Match up these larger Star Point 1/2-square triangles with the pieced triangles, right sides together. Carefully sew along the long side. Press to the Star Points Triangle. This unit should measure 4-1/2" (2-1/2").




5. Lay out your blocks as shown. Pay close attention to the illustration for placement. Sew rows together. Watch which way your half-squares twists. Press seams away from half-square triangles.



6. Sew rows together, matching seams at intersections. Make sure to catch the points of the half-square triangles right at the 1/4" seam. Press seams open to reduce bulk.

Make one block measuring 12-1/2" and four blocks measuring 6-1/2".



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
