You will make one 12" inch star and two 6" inch stars.

## Its easier than you think! No set-in seams.

Refer to diagram for layout.

## Cutting Star Points - Unit C and D

Lay your strips out. Place the 45 degree line of your ruler on the bottom edge of the strip. Cut the end of the strip off at a 45 degree angle. See pictures.

Next, put the 3" line (for 6 inch block, use the 1-3/4" line) of your ruler on the newly cut diagonal edge. Cut and repeat until you have 4 diamonds for Unit $C$. Repeat the process for Unit D. Hint: to ensure accuracy, before you cut, line up the 45 degree line on the bottom edge of
 your strip too.

## Sewing

Lay out your pieces according to the illustration at the top of the page.

Sew Unit $A$ to Unit $C$ and the corresponding Unit $A$ to Unit D. Match $1 / 4$ seam intersections at the side point of the diamond (C \&D) and the point of the triangle (A). The edge of the triangle will extend past the edge of the diamond. Illustration shows Unit $C$. When working with Unit $D$, it will be a mirror image of $C$.


Now attach a Unit $B$ to the $A C$ unit and one to the $A D$ unit. Refer to the illustration for correct placement. Again, the edge of the triangle will extend beyond the diamond. !!!Press Unit B away from Unit C BUT press Unit B toward Unit D!!!


Trim away any corners and points that hang over the $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance.

## Assembling the star blocks.

Pay close attention to the illustration for placement.

Create $1 / 4$ of the block by sewing $A B C$ unit to $A B D$ unit.
Match seams at the center, ends of diamonds and top
ABC
Unit
ABD
corners. Pin as needed. Press this seam open. Make four.
Unit

Next sew these 1/4-block segments together in pairs. Match seams at the center as well as the top and bottom edges of each segment. Press seams open.

Sew these 1/2-block segments together. Match the center points, seams at the diamonds and the outer edges. Press seam open. Trim to 12-1/2" (or 6-1/2" ).


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
