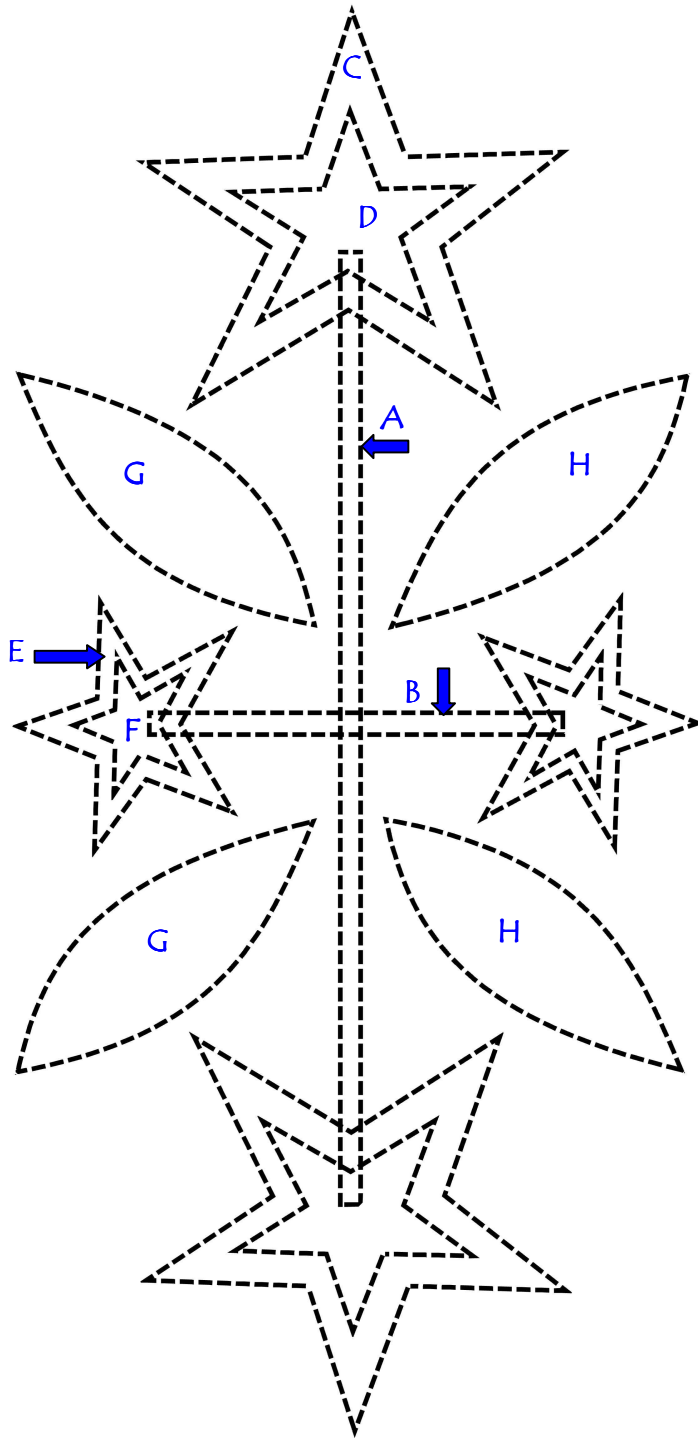


Starry Night Applique Block

General Instructions

Outline drawing is needs to be enlarged 300% to fit in the finished block measuring 12" wide by 24" tall.

To begin, cut your background fabric 13" by 25".

Mark center guidelines by folding your rectangle in half and pressing. Refold the other direction and press again. Be careful not to iron out your first crease. You may use a washable fabric marker instead of pressing, if desired.

Use your favorite applique method to create the block. Templates include seam allowances. If using a fusible method, ignore the seam allowances and cut out your pieces exactly on finished edge.

The pattern for Stem A is longer than a sheet of paper and runs across two pages. Please connect them so it is one long piece. Stars are doubled up to save space but should be treated as two elements.

Applique in this order, Stem A and B (centered on top of the creases), Stars C, D, E, F; then add leaves G and H.

Think about adding sparkle to your applique block with fancy embroidery stitches or beads and buttons.

When the block is completed, trim to 24-1/2' x 12-1/2". Make sure to keep your applique motif centered.
